

Alberta Environment has asked me to gather statements from Ramsay residents re. experiences during the ammonia leak in September to use in an ongoing investigation into the ammonia leak in Ramsay on Sept.13, 2009.

There is an ongoing investigation into the Ammonia leak at the Lilydale Chicken Plant.

We require statements from residents about their individual experiences on that date.

Of importance to note:

- Did you smell the ammonia?
- Did you or your family suffer any health effects?
- Location
- Did you know what to do (i.e. shelter-in-place, evacuate)
- Did you stay in your home or did you leave the area?
- If you stayed at home did you shut your windows and turn off your furnace?
- Could you smell the ammonia in your home?
- Please list any agencies you may have called including 911, 311, Health Link, AB Environment, Public Safety, etc.
